

COVID-19 Pre-Procedural Testing for Fully Vaccinated Patients

Starting Thursday, May 6, UI Health Care no longer requires pre-procedural COVID-19 testing for [fully vaccinated patients](#).

Patients are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after their final COVID-19 vaccine.

You will be required to provide documented proof of vaccination before your procedure and cannot have a scheduled procedure at UI Health Care until five days after any COVID-19 vaccine. If you cannot move your vaccination date, your procedure may need to be rescheduled.

If you need to reschedule your upcoming procedure, please contact the clinic directly.

If you will not be fully vaccinated by the date of your scheduled pre-procedural COVID-19 test, please keep your test as scheduled.

Vaccination documentation

You can show proof of vaccination in any of the ways listed below.

Contact the clinic your procedure is scheduled in

Vaccination documentation can be a photo of your COVID-19 vaccination card or documented proof of vaccination from a pharmacy or health care provider.
